



Poster Presentation Guidelines

Since UReS 2020 will be conducted as a live event the Poster session will also be conducted as a live event. For this, you are requested to provide your posters with a 2-minute narration (Please refer to the recording guidelines posted on UReS web for further information).

Slide Size : 84 x 118 cm Orientation
Orientation : Portrait
UReS Logo : All posters should include the UReS logo at the top right-hand corner of the poster.

Do not crowd the logo with any other graphic elements or text. Give it as much clear space as possible.

Higher-resolution UReS 2020 logo can be downloaded from LMS.

Structure of the poster

- Title
- Authors and affiliations
- Introduction/ background
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion/s
- References (max 5)

Organizing the content

- The title should follow with the author names; respective affiliations and the corresponding author email (Center-aligned, see the samples given on the UReS web)
- Do not typeset the title in all capital letters (such text is difficult to read).
- You may use any appropriate **font** but better to choose a clear font with a large inner space
 - Font suggestions : e.g Calibri (32 minimum), Tahoma (28 minimum), Arial (28 minimum)

Displaying and Presenting your poster

- Since UReS 2020 is scheduled to be held online you will need to record a 2-minute narration to go along with your poster slide.
- You need to upload the poster with the narration on or before **2 pm on 30th January 2021** to a specified virtual space given (Please refer to the Oral and Poster Recording Guidelines uploaded on the UReS web).
